Membership Category Explanations



Full Membership

Full membership is principally intended for members wishing to register fullblood Dorpers and White Dorpers. On applying for Full membership a person shall submit, for approval, a preferred prefix. Full members are able to register and transfer stud stock, Receive all Society publications, Invited to participate in National Sale and National Show. Full members are entitled to full voting rights at regional and federal levels. Voting rights – one vote per Full Membership. Full members are eligible for election to the Board and a Regional Committee.

Commercial Membership

Commercial membership is for any persons with an interest in the Dorper and White Dorper and/or may be a commercial producer. Commercial members receive Society publications but are not stud members and cannot register sheep. Commercial members can vote at Regional meetings, they cannot vote at Federal meetings. A Commercial member is eligible to hold a position on a Regional Committee but not the Board.

Junior Membership

Junior membership is for members aged 18 years old or younger. On applying for Junior membership a person shall submit, for approval, a preferred prefix. Junior membership allows the ownership of up to a maximum of 20 registered sheep. Junior members are able to register and transfer stud stock, Receive all Society publications, Invited to participate in National Sale and National Show. Junior members have no voting rights.

Stud Prefix and Flock Number

When applying for Full or Junior membership, every person accepted as a stud member of the Society intending to register sheep shall record a stud prefix (up to 20 letters) which shall be used as a prefix to and as part of the name of every sheep of which they are the breeder and which is submitted for registration. The use of the words 'Dorper' or 'White Dorper' is not permitted in a prefix.

Each member will be issued with a unique flock number by the registrar. A unique flock number can include both a Dorper and White Dorper flock with the same Prefix.

Registrars Discretion to Register Name

The registrar may decline to register or record any stud or flock name or stud prefix which, in the opinion of the registrar, resembles that of any other breeder of livestock whether in Australia or elsewhere or which they perceive as contrary to the interests of the Society.

More Than One Flock

If a person has more than one flock of sheep, whether running on the same property or elsewhere, that person may record with the Society a separate stud prefix in respect of each flock and pay the prescribed fee in respect of each.
