## **9<sup>th</sup> Queensland Dorper and White Dorper Multivendor Sale 2017** **Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> September, at 11am, St. George Showgrounds**

Dear Members

01<sup>st</sup> May, 2017

This letter is to inform you of the entry requirements for the Queensland Sale to be held at **11am on the 22<sup>nd</sup> September at St. George**. The process and rules for entry have been changed slightly so please read the following information carefully:

The QLD Sale will follow a similar format and rules as our National Sale and is designed to be a sale of registered Dorpers and White Dorpers (registered with DSSA). It provides an opportunity for breeders to showcase and sell their best animals. All registered studs able to enter QLD, are invited to submit registered animals, representative of the breed standards. The target is to have approximately 120 high quality animals on sale. Studs will be limited to a maximum of 10 entries per registered stud. The Sale Committee reserves the right to reduce the maximum number of entries per stud, if numbers exceed the sale limit. The cost of entry is **\$66 incl GST** per animal entered and is non-refundable.

**A non-refundable 50% booking fee** must be paid in advance with the balance being paid at the close of entries.

The order of sale in the catalogue will be based on last year's sale averages. Averages are calculated and are based on the total amount a vendor achieved from the sale of their animals at St George in 2016, divided by the number of animals presented for sale. This average includes animals passed in but excludes those withdrawn before the sale. Studs which did not enter animals in last year's sale will be catalogued in order of deposits paid.

**Elders St George** has been nominated as sale co-ordinators. The committee is liaising with Elders, Live Bidding and the DSSA to have catalogues and photos of sale animals put on their respective web sites.

### **1. Entry Requirements**

- 1.1. Interstate studs are asked to respect Queensland Biosecurity rules & standards.
- 1.2. Ewes have no age restrictions
- 1.3. Rams must be a minimum of 10 months old and there is a minimum weight for age requirement:

Ram with lambs' teeth	–	60kg
Ram with two teeth or over	–	70kg

Loss of teeth or signs of eruption put an animal up into the next weight category
- 1.4 Registered studs may enter a total of ten (10) animals per stud. If you only pay one membership and record both Dorper & White Dorper the total entry per stud is from the combined breeds.

### **2. Animal Requirements**

- 2.1 Animals must be registered with the DSSA
- 2.2 Animals presented for sale must be 'Vendor Prefix' only, i.e. they must be bred by the vendor
- 2.3 Animals must be clean and well-presented
- 2.4 All sheep must be tagged with an approved NLIS tag.
- 2.5 Ewes in the last trimester of pregnancy should not be brought to the sale

### **3. Health Status**

- 3.1 Queensland entry requirements exist for livestock. People wishing to introduce livestock will have a **Biosecurity Obligation** not to introduce any disease into Qld. They should either contact the Biosecurity Queensland Call Centre on 07 3404 6999 or access the website [www.business.qld.gov.au](http://www.business.qld.gov.au) "Livestock entry requirements for Queensland", for further details.
- 3.2 All rams and ewes must be from Ovine Brucellosis accredited flocks.
- 3.3 All entries must be declared negative or able to be proved free of Ovine Dermatoparaxis. Lincoln University in New Zealand is DSSA preferred for Dermatoparaxis testing. Forms and blood cards can be obtained by email at

Jon.Hickford@lincoln.ac.nz. Blood cards should be requested from Lincoln University ASAP (posted from NZ) and to allow testing results to be back in time. NB TEST RESULTS CAN TAKE UP TO A MONTH to be returned.

3.4 All entries must be free of lice and footrot

#### 4 Sale Protocols

- 4.1 Arrival to be **between 1pm and 5pm Thursday, 21<sup>st</sup> September 2017 at the St. George Showground.**
- 4.2 Rams will be weighed by 5pm Thursday, 21<sup>st</sup> of September 2017.
- 4.3 All entries will be inspected on arrival by sale committee representatives. Rams must have sound mouth and testicles and any animal with a structural fault will be rejected by the committee.
- 4.4 The Sale Committee reserves the right to reject an animal entered in the sale if they are considered unsound, in poor condition, unrepresentative of the Breed Standards or not meeting sale entry conditions. These animals will need to be removed from the premises.
- 4.5 Only animals catalogued are to be brought to the Showgrounds and submitted for sale.
- 4.6 The Sale Committee will allow substitutions for exceptional circumstances up until September 20<sup>th</sup>. Please contact the sale co-ordinator ASAP if you need to make a substitution. You **cannot** substitute an animal that fails the pre-sale inspection.
- 4.7 Elders will be the sole agent this year with Peter Sealy 0428-626959 & Brendan Devine 0428-255568 the main points of contact. Vendors will be charged 7% commission on the sale of their animals.
- 4.8 Vendors can set their own reserves above the upset price.
- 4.9 A meeting with the Vendors and Agent will be held the morning of the sale to discuss upset prices, reserves etc. Any animal that does not receive a bid and is passed in throughout the sale WILL be taken home by the vendor and WILL NOT be sold after the sale.
- 4.10 A 2% rebate will apply for outside agents introducing buyers to the sale. This cost will be shared across the board by all vendors (refer to rebate in more detail in the catalogue)
- 4.11 Vendors and purchasers are responsible for checking with their local Department of Agriculture in regard to the correct paperwork for moving animals. Any animals derived from a tick infected area must be treated prior to the sale as specified by their local DAFF inspector.
- 4.12 Any breaches of sale protocol must be brought to the attention of the sale committee which could result in the offending Stud not being able to participate in the Qld. Sale for a period of 2 years. **The committee's decision will be final.**
- 4.13 **ONLY LAMBPLAN** figures can be displayed. Independent scanning results and figures are not permitted to be displayed.

#### 5. Paperwork Requirements

- 5.1 All animals must be registered with the DSSA prior to entry.
- 5.2 All ewes which have had reproductive surgery (ET or AI) or have been running with rams must either be certified as scanned in lamb, or have a lamb at foot.
- 5.3 Return booking forms & deposits to Lisa Burr at the DSSA office by Sunday, **25<sup>th</sup> June.**
- 5.4 Completed, **but undated**, National Vendor Declarations, Sheep Health Statements (originals) and copy of Brucellosis Certificate, must be posted or emailed to the Sale Co-ordinator, Angela O'Donnell – 181 Hermitage-Emu Vale Road, THE HERMITAGE, QLD, 4370 by the **16<sup>th</sup> July.** Please ensure that you keep copies of this documentation as you will need to have it with you when you travel to St. George.
- 5.5 Please send completed Ram & Ewe entry forms to Lisa Burr –DSSA, ABRI - UNE, Armidale NSW, 2351 by the **6<sup>th</sup> of August.** Balance of entry fees owing to be paid by this date.
- 5.6 You must indicate on the entry form if you want your Lambplan figures included in the catalogue. Typing results noted in the catalogue comments must state the date typing was conducted & the inspector who typed the animal.
- 5.7 Entries will only be accepted on an official entry form.

6 <sup>th</sup> August <b>Entries Close</b>	<b>All vendors will be required to have submitted the entries of the animals they wish to enter in the Qld. Sale.</b> • <b>Post or email entries to Lisa Burr at the DSSA office, accompanied by the balance of the entry fees owing.</b>

**Testing requirements including declaration of *O.Dermatosparaxis* and *O.Brucellosis* must be completed and a copy supplied to the sale co-ordinator or chairman on or before sale day, otherwise they will not be accepted.**
