The Dorper Sheep Society of Australia is again offering the option of two tiers of membership for stud members from 1st January 2019 to 31st December 2019.

Tier 1 is the standard full stud membership of \$350 if you receive correspondence via email or \$400 if you receive correspondence via post. This membership allows online registrations to be processed at \$6.60 per animal.

Tier 2 membership is an additional cost of \$275 incl. GST (to be a Tier 2 member you must pay the full membership fee plus the Tier 2 membership fees). If you choose to pay both subscriptions, online registrations will be charged at \$4.40 per animal.

If you intend on registering more than 125 sheep in this year the Tier 2 option is the most cost effective.

Members are permitted to swap between Membership Tiers each year to allow members the opportunity to get their registrations up to date.

If you are wishing to become a Tier 2 member please sign and return the form below. Please note Tier 2 payment of \$275 must be received before any registrations can be processed at the discounted rate. Any registrations submitted prior to receipt of Tier 2 payment will be processed at the full rate.
