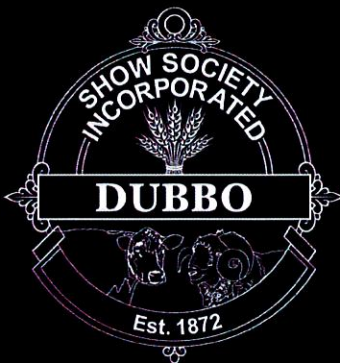

Stud Pass: \$55 will purchase a Stud Exhibitor Pass consisting of passes for three people for the duration of the show. **This Stud Pass can only be purchased at the time of submission of entries & will not be available at any other time.** Additional \$15 one day passes may be pre-purchased at time of submission of entries if required. Gate/ Vehicle pass, & receipt will be available on Thursday before the show at the sheep office. (Office hours 10am - 7pm)

Wristbands will be placed on each person holding a three-day pass when admission ticket is presented on first entering the Showground. Wristbands are to be worn at all times.

Only one wristband will be issued per three-day ticket & it is your responsibility to look after the band for the three days of the Show. If wristband is broken, it will be replaced at the Show Office on presentation of damaged band. If band is lost, purchase of another ticket will be needed before re-entry to the Showground.

Student Gate Passes: The Show Society offers a \$15 3 day gate pass for Students with Sheep Exhibits. **This gate pass will only be available with the entry form and must be paid for with entries.**

PLEASE NOTE:

Vehicles passes from 123Tix will be issued, vehicle rego numbers must be supplied:- **Vehicle Passes are not transferrable and will be scanned on entry.**

Entry via Gate 5. Check with Chief Steward for parking designated area. No vehicle entry after 9am.

All Exhibitors are required to remove their vehicle immediately once sheep have been unloaded.

On SUNDAY VEHICLES MUST REMAIN IN THE PARKING AREA until advised by the Traffic Controller that they may be brought to the loading area for departure. (Vehicles must not be brought to the shed for departure until a time advised, based on the distance to be travelled).

Sheep may arrive on THURSDAY between the hours of 9am & 9pm ONLY.

All Sheep to be removed by 7am Monday 13th May 2024

PLEASE ADVISE THE CO-ORDINATOR ASAP IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO COME TO THE SHOW OR TO BRING ALL THE SHEEP ENTERED. Please DO NOT bring more sheep than entered.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Dubbo Show Society's Exhibitors Regulations apply to all sections of the Show & that the Conditions of Entry following, which apply to these sections only, are merely supplementary to & subject to the Exhibitors Regulations. A copy of the Exhibitors Regulations is available in the Dubbo Annual Show Schedule or upon request from the Show Office.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

These conditions apply to Sections E, F, F (1) & F (2) unless otherwise stated in the breed section.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- 1 **COMPETITORS ENTER AT OWN RISK.**
- 2 **Working With Children-** Exhibitors must comply with all working with Children legislation. (see Exhibitors Regulations for details)
- 3 **Entry, National Sheep Health Statement, National Vendor Declaration, Indemnity & Waiver Forms must be fully completed, signed by the Exhibitor &, with the fees, form part of the Entry Form.**
- 4 No stock shall be unloaded without completed Declaration. Exhibitors showing infected sheep may be liable to a fine of \$10,000.00 as per Government regulations.
- 5 Sheep will be penned in accordance with OJD MAP regulations. A copy of the Certificate of Compliance will be available from the Sheep Show Office.
- 6 Sheep must be from a Flock not infected or suspected of being infected with OJD.
- 7 **EXHIBITORS WHO REQUIRE SEGREGATION IN PENNING AREA, BOARDS WILL BE AVAILABLE.**
- 8 Entries are limited to flocks which are registered in a recognized flock book with a Breed Society or Association & must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor (see separate Merino condition of entry).
- 9 All entries must be from an accredited brucellosis free flock.
- 10 Ewes in the last trimester of pregnancy should not be brought to the show.
- 11 All Entries must be tagged with PIC tags according to NLIS regulations. All Entries must have individual identification Tag number & all other NLIS regulations adhered to.
- 12 Trucks should be thoroughly cleaned & washed prior to loading sheep for the Show.
- 13 **FEED & WATER CONTAINERS** should be supplied by the Exhibitor & must be at least 30cm above the ground. Limited numbers of feed & water containers may be hired through the Sheep Show Office. Any hired containers should be returned to the stockpile prior to the conclusion of the Show.
- 14 **CLEANING:** Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning of pens, & lanes outside pens. Lanes to be swept by exhibitor at least each morning.
- 15 **STUD SIGNS** are to be limited to a single sign per exhibitor with dimensions no greater than 2 metres x 0.5 metres.
- 16 **INSPECTION OF SHEEP:** Sheep will be inspected prior to judging by an appointed panel of inspectors. Before any inspection takes place the Chief Steward & the Breed Steward are to be consulted.
- 17 The Chief Steward shall be the final arbitrator in the event of any dispute arising following inspection of sheep. All exhibitors have the right to appeal the chief's steward's determination if the Exhibitor does not accept the determination, the Show Society's Veterinary Officer is engaged to assess the sheep. the Veterinarian decision is final. If the animal in the veterinarian's opinion is not fit for exhibition & the exhibitor has engaged the appeals process, the exhibitor is therefore, liable to pay for all veterinary costs associated with the appeals process. any sheep that fails the inspection for veterinary process must be removed from the showground immediately by the Exhibitor.

18 Any health concerns should be immediately notified to the Chief Steward. Any Animal deemed to be unwell will be referred to the District Veterinary Officer or Show Society Veterinary Officer.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1 ALL SHEEP TO BE PENNED BY 9pm on Thursday prior to the Show & remain in pens until 2pm Sunday of the Show.**
- 2 All Sheep to be removed by 7am Monday following the Show. Order of loading & departure will be advised based on distance sheep are to travel & a roster will be displayed in the tearoom & Sheep Office window regarding Schools departing first.
- 3 Initial bedding will be provided by the Society. Additional bedding may be purchased through the Sheep Show Office & will be available early morning or late afternoon.
- 4 Up to two (2) entries are permitted per exhibitor per class unless otherwise specified. Schools may have up to three (3) entries per class except for scanning & best head classes.
- 5 If total entries are more than the number of sheep capable of being penned, the Society reserves the right to request intending exhibitors to reduce the number of animals entered. Pairs may have to be penned together.
- 6 First places in each open class automatically are entered for the CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION classes. For Reserve Champion, the second place to the champion in their class becomes eligible. No further entry required.
- 7 **WINNER OF SCANNING CLASS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR CHAMPION** (must have won its individual class)
- 8 **GROUP CLASSES** must be drawn from general entries but are a separate entry & entry fee must be paid. Pairs are not to be drawn from single classes unless otherwise stated in breed conditions.
- 9 **MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR:** Points awarded as follows: 1st place 3 points; 2nd place 2 points; 3rd place 1 point. No points shall be allocated **where there are less than three (3) Entries in the class. Points awarded in Novice Classes shall not be included in Open Section Most Successful Exhibitor. No Most Successful Exhibitor Award will be made where there are less than three (3) Exhibitors in the breed. Group Classes not included.**
- 10 **SPECIAL PRIZES** Champion / Special Award PRIZE MONEY may be collected from the **Sheep Show Office** during the office Hours. Exhibitors are urged to collect prize money at the Show to avoid possible inconvenience later. Any prize money not collected by 11am Sunday of the Show (will be available for collection from the Show Society Secretary's Office up until 30th June current year of the Show.) Any prize money not collected by this date will be forfeited.
- 11 All perpetual trophies remain the property of the Dubbo Show Society & must be returned to the Chief Steward immediately following judging.
- 12 The Dubbo Show Society Code of Conduct must be adhered to by all exhibitors, participants & spectators at all times.
- 13 **RIBBONS & PRIZEMONEY -**
In a single class, a ribbon or other evidence of a previous award shall not be worn or displayed in the ring. (Ribbons may be awarded throughout the sheep section in accordance with the following - 5 exhibits & under - up to 3 ribbons; 6 to 10 exhibits - 4 ribbons; 11 to 15 exhibits - 5 ribbons.) Prize money & or Product will be awarded as follows – Champion \$40; Reserve Champion \$20 & or equivalent. (Where insufficient numbers, classes may be combined to become Junior/Senior classes. Ribbons will not be presented in any particular breed unless there is competition within that breed ie: more than one exhibitor).
- 14 Judges must declare any conflict of interest which may arise, such as family members, particularly in Interbreed judging. In the event of a conflict of interest a stand-in Judge will be appointed by the Chief Steward to undertake judging for the class of interest.
NOVICE SECTION.
- 15 All Novice Class sheep must be bred by the Exhibitor & are open to exhibitors who have never won a first prize at any Royal Show, Feature Breed Show, ASSBA Show or an Open Class at Dubbo Show. A breeder is no longer eligible for the Novice Section after exhibiting at Dubbo Show three (3) times.
- 16 Schools may enter Novice classes regardless of prior history.
- 17 Those exhibitors entering in the Novice Section cannot enter the same class in the Open Section. Where no class is available for Novice Exhibitors entries may be made in the Open Section.
- 18 **FIRST & SECOND PLACES** in a novice class are automatically entered in the same class in the Open Section where available. No further entry is required.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR MERINO SHEEP

1. All sheep must be inspected by the Committee prior to judging to see that such sheep comply with the Regulations.
2. At the exhibitor's request, the Judge will inspect any sheep & have it placed in the correct class.
3. Exhibitors must state shearing dates with entries.
4. Ages of sheep in all sections shall be determined by teeth, & not by years.
5. Any sheep showing an uneven number of teeth is eligible to compete in next older Class.

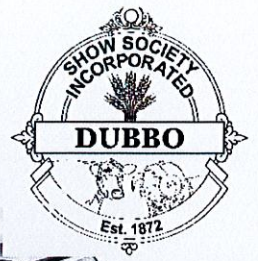
